The Stupefying Succulents




As you may recall, whenever you water one succulent, enough water soaks the surrounding soil that any (horizontally or vertically) adjacent succulents do not need to be watered.

Because of this, you've decided to employ the following *succulent strategy*: you will stroll through the garden from one entrance to the other without revisiting a succulent, watering every third succulent you visit, starting with the second and ending with the second-to-last.

Unfortunately, some of the succulents are *spacious* and *spiky*. You can't stroll on the squares containing these succulents, so you'll have to make sure you water an adjacent succulent instead.

Note: you needn't visit every non-spiky succulent. You just need to make sure they get enough water. Here's an example path through a small garden:
