

***READING RESPONSE GUIDELINES***

Your Reading Response (RR) is due 24 hours before class (so on Thursday, Sunday, or Tuesday at 12:30 pm). It can be typed directly into Canvas, or you can produce a document and upload it. (If you are not yet enrolled and so do not have access to Canvas, write your report as an email and send it to Professor Arms.)

Each RR should include the following three parts.

- A. Respond to any questions or instructions included with the reading assignment.
- B. Write down at least two explicit questions you have about the reading. This could be, for instance, something that was unclear to you, or a request for more information about some point in the reading, or speculation about the relation of the reading to previous ideas in the course or in other subjects you have studied.
- C. Write down an estimate of how much time you have spent on Math 441 outside of class since the last RR.

For the first response on 9/27, this will be just the time spent reading and writing the RR. Later it will include your work on problems.

Each RR will be graded on a 0 to 2 scale.

- 2 points means you included everything asked for in your RR.
- 1 point means you didn't give one of the responses asked for, or your responses were seriously lacking in some way.
- No RR, or one with almost no satisfactory content, of course gets a score of 0.
