

Wig in a Box

"Flip, fro, frizz, flop, it's all because of you."



Each of these grids contains two types of clues: **row** clues, which are given in order and written normally, and **hair** clues, which must be styled to match the wig before being placed in the grid. Hairs may be rotated. Additionally, two hair clues in each grid are **crosshairs**; their paths are not given, and instead they extend outside the bounds of the grid.

Once you've made all six wigs, build a box!
